“Mosquito Control Online” is the name of the Intranet created by Dr. He (Harry) Zhong, assistant professor at the JA Mulrennan Sr. Research Lab at Florida’s A & M University, using Intranets.com.

Professor Zhong uses his Intranet to disseminate scientific literature and information on professional conferences to colleagues in the field of mosquito control, as well as to hold forum discussions and to coordinate schedules for his research team at Florida A & M.

“I like the Intranets.com product a lot,” says Zhong.

Using the Intranets.com database function, he has set up an extensive abstract database related to pesticide non-target impact.

The database can be searched by a variety of parameters and contains a listing for some 1154 articles on everything from the “Effects of mosquito abatement pesticide treatments on honey bees” to the “Inhibition of acetylcholinesterase from different species by organophosphorus compounds, carbamates and methylsulphonylfluoride.”

Colleagues can search this database by author, date, short view and ESA format, and then email Zhong for a hardcopy of any article they want, he explains.

Dr. Zhong says it was very easy to set up the database with Intranets.com -- using and modifying the templates that the product provides. “You can set up your database so you can sort and group data by date, creator, region or any other field. You can create multiple views for later viewing by everyone that uses the Intranet.”

So far, he says only a small number of professionals have begun using his Intranet, but he believes that number will grow. “We need to educate the public on the value of Intranets, vs. the Internet,” Zhong says.

Besides his extensive abstract database, he has set up forum discussions on the West Nile Virus, and a free-of-charge online registration site to be used by mosquito control conference organizers.

Professor Zhong is so enthusiastic about his Intranet that he says he has paid for 10 membership user fees for his colleagues just to get them to try it out.
